## Information for residents and businesses

We will be carrying out pavement reconstruction works on the even numbered side only – from the junction with Chalkpit Lane to access way at Ashcombe School opposite no.89 and replacement or adjustment of all vehicle cross over dropped kerbs and taper kerbs to include the exit way opposite no. 89 and the two accesses (entrance and exit) into the Bradley Building.

On the odd numbered side - there will be no pavement reconstruction works, however there will be replacement or adjustment of all Vehicle Cross Over kerbs from nos 35 to 99.

The carriageway will be under temporary traffic control during the works.

We will make sure you can get to and from your house or business. Talk to a member of our staff on site about if you need help – talking to our staff can solve most issues.

### Delays in work

Our work is sometimes delayed by bad weather. We will keep you updated on any changes via the advance warning signs.

### Parking

It is essential to keep the road free from parked vehicles. Please park somewhere else otherwise your vehicle may be towed away.

### Noise

There will be some noise but we will try to keep this to a minimum.
