

Deputy IT Network Manager

Required asap to take responsibility for our ICT Network. This is a technical role 36 hours a week/52 weeks per year.

We are well resourced and ICT facilities are excellent throughout the school. Currently in ICT we have 300 Staff/admin PCs and 560 Student PCs. The Windows network is supported by 5 physical servers and 14 VMware 6.7 virtual servers. We operate four core switches which are configured for redundancy and our edge switches are predominately Hewlett Packard units. Printing is provided through PaperCut. Every classroom is networked. We operate a Unifi Wi-Fi network for staff and 6th Form. We have a 200/200mbps BT Unicorn internet connection and we have a Smoothwall UTM for filtering. We use Office 365 for mail and Sharepoint to share documents and resources with students. The team consists of a Network Manager, Deputy Network Manager and three additional IT technicians who provide front line support to staff.

The successful candidate will:

- Have good working knowledge of Windows, Windows Server, Office 365, Active Directory;
- Have the ability to ensure the school network is configured appropriately;
- Have working knowledge of VLANs;
- Have excellent analytical skills;
- Be able to work on own initiative and as part of a team;
- Previous experience of working in a school environment is desirable but not essential.
